Practice Popcorn words

Make a summer Journal - color one space for each day you write about.

Make up rhyming words

Practice writing your first and last name 7 times

Ask an adult or an older sibling for words that you can practice sounding out

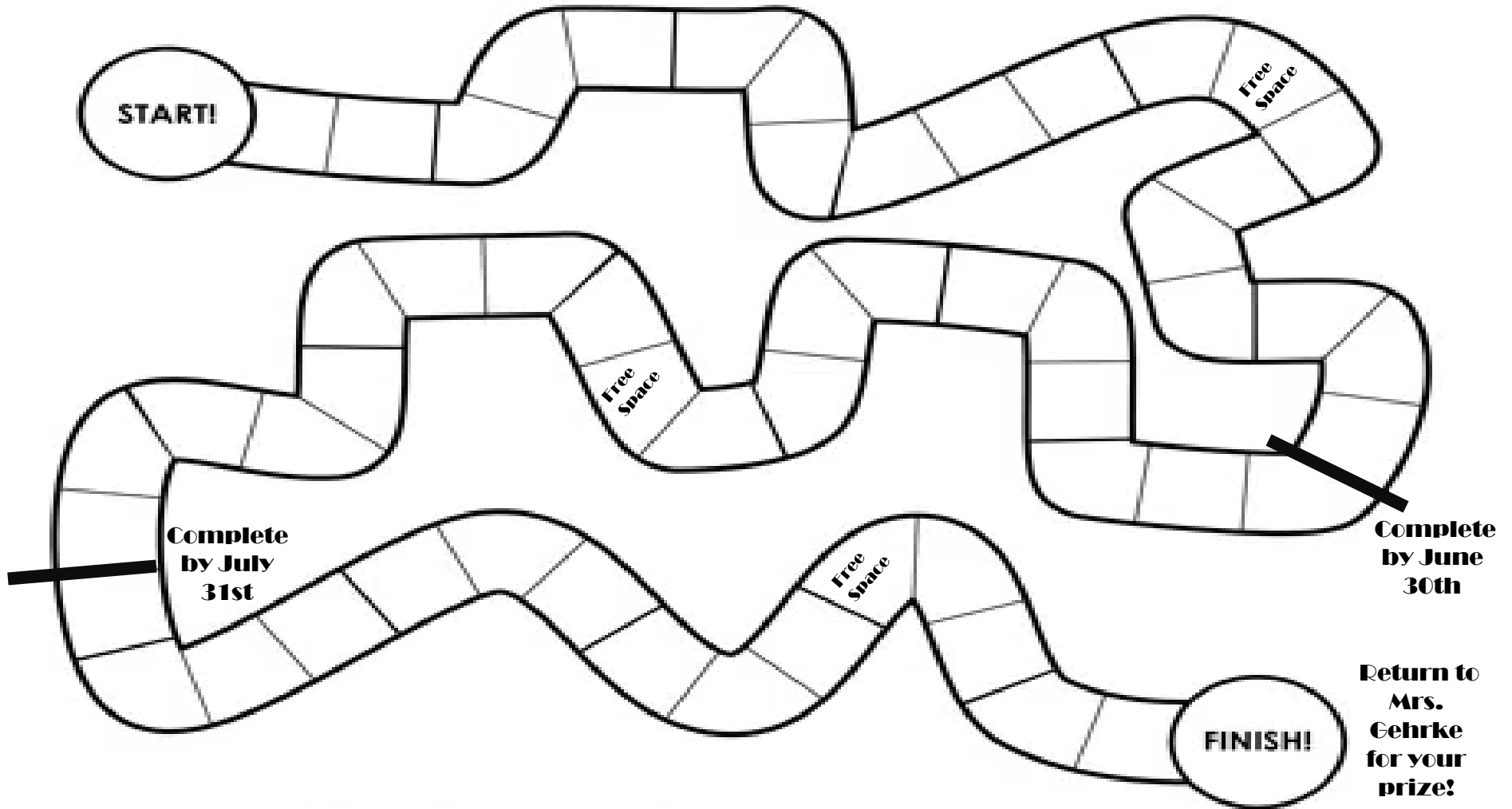
Practice the sounds the letters make
